Review progress on our 2021-2022 school wide goals

Overall MOY school composite score for DIBELS went from 71% to 75% with a 4% increase.

MOY Math scored 41% at or above grade level.

Present and discuss data trends from Acadience/DIBELS and iready math (MOY).

Growth per grade:

Kindergarten +17

- 1st grade +10
- 2nd -1
- 3rd -1
- 4th +4
- 5th +5

6th -8

Goal #1: (DIBELS) Increase MOY by 10% at or above benchmark.

Goal #2: (MATH) MOY 41% at or above grade level. EOY 60% at or above grade level.

Goal #3: (SEL) Students Kindergarten-4th grades showed at or about 90% proficiency at the end of each unit. 5th and 6th grade were just below 90%.

Discuss and identify our school's and student's greatest academic needs.

More structured interventions

• 6th grade interventions could be earlier in the day and more student directed.

Iready & Reading lessons could be taught based on diagnostic or comprehension check lists where teacher could use data to assign the appropriate lessons to each individual student to prevent losing student engagement.

• Are students staying challenged and engaged?

- Teacher can move students' path up or down.
- Motivate students by using a weekly champion or reward system.

Feedback from teachers.

- SEL management: Maybe a completion goal as in did they teach all lessons or didn't.
- Aides vs. Tutors: suggested ½ day aides for all classes within grade level or 1st combined with 2nd, 3rd combined with 4th, and 5th combined with 6th.
- Goal related to PLC's: Complete during faculty meeting or before flipped faculty meeting. Use time to go over math data too.
