Reviewed progress towards current goals-

- Reading- 80% proficient in oral reading fluency
- \* MOY currently happening, data will be reviewed
- Increase Teacher capacity: book study, The Behavior Code and SEL
- \* Well under way
- Increase median growth of below proficient students in math
- \* PLC teams meet regularly to analyze data and make adjustments to instruction
- \*iReady and Imagine Math programs used to support individual learning and growth

Discussed ideas for School Improvement Plan goals for the coming school year. Some ideas include:

- SEL- analyzing needs and making goals to support SEL focus
- Reading Tutors- has been a great benefit to the students, would like to continue if possible
- Technology 1:1- currently 3-6 are 1:1, moving lower grades to 1:1
- Suggestion to observe how the technology is currently used to determine needs
- Purchase Software; iReady, Imagine Math
- STEAM grant for each grade level to be used towards grade specific goals to meet student needs
- O Engineering is Elementary is a standard across grade levels 1-6
- Differentiation training- strengthen tier 1 and tier 2 instruction to meet the needs of all learners
- More rigorous
- o Real world
- Move ALL students, not just the lower performing students
- O Book study: Moving Beyond Quadrant A

A discussion to improve communication between teachers and parents took place.
